



Job Title: Academic Medical Physicist ICP – Physics and Engineering Location: London Health Sciences Centre – London Regional Cancer Program Regular/Temporary: Regular Full/Part Time: Full-Time Posting Period: January 14 – January 28, 2021

The London Health Sciences Centre (LHSC) is seeking an Academic Medical Physicist to join the Radiation Treatment team. LHSC's London Regional Cancer Program (LRCP) is the lead academic regional cancer provider for Southwestern Ontario and provides a comprehensive range of cancer care services to a population of 1.5 million. The Medical Physics staff complement currently consists of 13 physicists, 3 physics associates, and 3 physics resident positions as well as summer students and other key program support staff. The LRCP continuously acquires and maintains state-of-the-art radiation therapy equipment. This includes nine high-energy linear accelerators (four of which are Varian True Beam linear accelerators and one Tomotherapy unit), HDR and LDR brachytherapy, two CT scanners, access to MRI, PET/CT, and hybrid PET/MRI for treatment planning and monitoring, and treatment planning systems (Philips Pinnacle, Varian Eclipse, RayStation, and Mim Software). The Radiation Treatment Program provides high quality, innovative radiation treatment services and supports a strong academic Radiation Oncology Division within the Department of Oncology, Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry at Western University. Medical Physicists have academic appointments in the Department of Oncology with cross-appointments in Medical Biophysics for the supervision and teaching of graduate students in a CAMPEP accredited graduate program operated in collaboration with the LRCP and Department of Oncology. The LRCP maintains an active Medical Physics Residency program, also accredited by CAMPEP since 2006. The Academic Medical Physicist will join a very dynamic Medical Physics team and will participate in all aspects of clinical physics, and will carry academic responsibilities outlined by the Department of Medical Biophysics. This 5-year term position offers a split between non-tenure track/non-UWOFA academic activities and clinical activities, outlined by Medical Physics at LRCP (PIPSC). Academic responsibilities include, but not limited to teaching of multiple graduate and undergraduate level courses, supervision of graduate students, and directing the CAMPEP graduate program.
