The Vitalité Health Network is the hospital health network that provides healthcare services in the north and southeast regions of New Brunswick. The Dr. Leon-Richard Oncology Centre, situated in Moncton, is the leader in oncology services for the network and provides complete services in chemotherapy and radiation oncology.

The Oncology Centre currently operates with four Elekta linear accelerators, one HDR remote afterloader, one orthovoltage unit, one 4D CT-SIM and several different treatment planning systems (Pinnacle for EBRT, Brachyvision and VariSeed for brachytherapy). The Centre also has a very active prostate brachytherapy program (HDR and Permanent seed implants) and gynecological brachytherapy program.

Job Summary:

Medical Physicists participate on several levels of the cancer control program. Under the supervision of the Chief Physicist, the candidate will contribute, among other things, to the equipment quality control programme in radiation oncology, to the development and commissioning of new treatment techniques and modalities, to the commissioning of new equipment, to the training and continuing education of Radiation Oncology staff, and to the radiation safety programme. The candidate could also be asked to manage working groups on special projects.

Requirements:

Master's degree (M.Sc) or a Doctorate degree (Ph.D.) in medical physics or physics;

Certification by the Canadian College of Physicists in Medicine OR Eligible for certification in 2022;

In-depth knowledge of the following equipment or techniques;

Linear accelerators with kV imaging, 4D CT-Simulators, IMRT, SBRT and VMAT treatment techniques, High Dose Rate Brachytherapy, Prostate Permanent Seed Implant Brachytherapy (I-125);

Ability to be well organized, to manage one's time and to set priorities;

Excellent interpersonal and communication skills;

Ability to function in a changing work environment;
