- Actively participates in patient chart checks (initial, continuing, and final) and treatment plan reviews, image fusion, dose calculation verifications, and special physics consultations as requested by physicians.
- Keeps abreast of new scientific methods and developments.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Prefer Certification by the American Board of Radiology, or American Board of Medical Physics in Therapeutic Medical Physics, however may consider Board Eligible applicants.
- Interacts effectively and efficiently both verbally and in writing with department staff regarding medical physics and radiation safety issues, and consults the chief physicist when uncertain how to handle a given problem
- Committed desire to collaborate and communicate with other members of the team to deliver clinical excellence.
