# TERMS OF REFERENCE SEPTEMBER 2019

#### REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

- 1. The committee is a standing sub-committee of the Canadian Organization of Medical Physicists (COMP).
- 2. The Chair of the sub-committee reports to chair of the Education Committee.

#### **PURPOSE**

The Committee will:

1. promote and support medical physics residency education programs and program directors with respect to the training and professional development of residents or residency program faculty.

# RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- 1. To coordinate and organize the work of COMP in respect to residency education.
- 2. To report regularly to the Education Committee and its Chair, including a biannual report and presentation of the recommendations and budget if applicable.
- 3. To work with, as appropriate, other committees or sub-committees on initiatives that relate to residency.
- 4. To assess the need for, oversee and provide support for educational offerings related to residency.
- 5. To receive communication on a national level from CAMPEP via COMP's CAMPEP representative.
- 6. To oversee, coordinate or provide support for national initiatives related to residency training.

# **MEMBERSHIP**

The Sub-Committee is composed of:

- 1. a chair or co-chairs who is approved by the Education committee for a term of three years;
- 2. a vice-chair who will serve for up to 3 years.
- 3. Program Directors (or designate) from Canadian Residency Programs (who are also COMP members) (up to 1 representative per Program)
- 4. other members as required

#### MEETINGS

1. The sub-committee should meet a minimum of two times a year, either by teleconference or in person.

- 1. A quorum consists of the committee chair and at least three other members.
- 2. Summary minutes of meetings will be taken and all decisions shall be recorded.
- 3. The committee should function as far as possible by consensus, otherwise a majority decision will be respected. The chair shall have the deciding vote in the case of a tie. Recommendations to the COMP Board may also include a minority opinion.

Committee members will be invited to serve a term of 3 years on the committee and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms. A Committee member who has completed two terms, may re-join the committee after a one-year period. Note: In special circumstances, the Committee Chair may deem that the committee will be best served by the continued participation of a member who has completed two terms. In these circumstances, the Committee Chair may choose to invite the member to continue on the committee.

# **BUDGET**

An annual budget for the committee will be prepared and submitted to the Chair of the Education Committee.
