MEDICAL PHYSICIST (Full Time)

The Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Program at the Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre (RVH) is seeking a dynamic and motivated **Medical Physicist** to join our growing program. The successful candidate will join our Medical Physics team, which currently includes 5 Medical Physicists, 2 Physics Associates, 2 Engineering Technologists, and an Information Technology Specialist. The Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Centre is in the city of Barrie, the gateway to central Ontario's cottage and ski country.

The Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Centre opened in June 2012. The radiation treatment program is equipped with one Varian Truebeam Linac and three Varian Clinac iX Linacs (scheduled for replacement in 2024 and 2025). The program also utilizes a Canon Exceed LB CT simulator, Bravos HDR brachytherapy, Eclipse treatment planning system and the ARIA oncology information system. The Medical Physics team is currently working closely with Diagnostic Imaging to install a PET-CT scanner and expanded MRI services at the RVH.

The successful candidate will be responsible for clinical duties including acceptance and commissioning of equipment, new technique and protocol implementation, quality assurance, chart checking, clinical consultations with physicians and therapists, and staff education. Medical Physicists have opportunities to participate in research activities through RVH's Research Institute. Occasional evening and weekend hours are required to meet the clinical needs of the program.

- MSc or PhD in medical physics.
- Successful completion of an accredited medical physics residency training program.
- CCPM, or equivalent certification, is an asset.
