EDUCATION COMMITTEE



TERMS OF REFERENCE AUGUST 2017

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

- 1. The committee is a standing committee of the Canadian Organization of Medical Physicists (COMP).
- 2. The Chair of the committee is a member of the COMP Board.
- 3. The chair will present a written report to the COMP Board prior to each in-person Board meeting and the Annual General Meeting of COMP.

PURPOSE

The Committee will:

1. promote and support medical physics education, training and professional development for those within the profession.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- 1. To coordinate and organize the work of COMP in respect to education and training and to monitor performance against agreed objectives and targets in the strategic plan;
- 2. To report regularly to the COMP Board, including a biannual report and presentation of recommendations and an annual budget for approval;
- 3. To oversee and provide support for any educational offerings, including the Winter School;
- 4. To assess the need for, oversee, and provide support for the Winter School and other educational offerings organized by COMP from time to time;
- 5. To advise the COMP Board on matters pertaining to CAMPEP, and provide to the COMP Board a list of nominees for the CAMPEP Board;
- 6. To oversee and provide support for the Students' Committee;
- 7. To oversee and provide support for the Residents' Committee;
- 8. To oversee and provide support for the Residency Program Directors' Committee;
- 9. To provide financial support for regional medical physics educational offerings in Canada brought forward by COMP members;
- 10. To ensure that education offerings developed by COMP are accredited.

MEMBERSHIP

The Committee is composed of:

1. a chair who is approved by the COMP Board for a term of three years;

- 2. the COMP Board Vice-President;
- 3. the Chair or co-Chairs of the Student Sub-Committee;
- 4. the Chair of the Residents' Sub-Committee;
- 5. the Chair of the Residency Program Directors' Sub-Committee;
- 6. the Chair of the Winter School;
- 7. the CAMPEP representative;
- 8. other members as required.

Committee members will be invited to serve a term of 3 years on the committee and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms. A Committee member who has completed two terms, may re-join the committee after a one-year period. Note: In special circumstances, the Committee Chair may deem that the committee will be best served by the continued participation of a member who has completed two terms. In these circumstances, the Committee Chair may choose to invite the member to continue on the committee.

MEETING

- 1. The committee should meet a minimum of two times a year, either by teleconference or in person.
- 2. A quorum consists of the committee chair and at least three other members.
- 3. Summary minutes of meetings will be taken and all decisions shall be recorded.
- 4. The committee should function as far as possible by consensus, otherwise a majority decision will be respected. The chair shall have the deciding vote in the case of a tie. Recommendations to the COMP Board may also include a minority opinion.

BUDGET

An annual budget for the committee will be prepared and submitted to the COMP Treasurer.
